

Needleart 2009 At Montpelier Mansion

This will be our 14_{th} year of turning this wonderful mansion into a gallery for your needleart. The dates of the show are Friday, July 17_{th} thru Sunday, July 26^{th} , 2009. Drop off is July $12_{th} \& 13_{th}$ at the mansion. Remember **no** piece is "not good enough to enter!"

Eligibility

All Needleart entries must have been made by the living exhibitor with a hand held threaded needle and be appropriately finished. All pictures and wall hangings must be wired for display purposes. Articles entered in last years' exhibit are not eligible. The acceptance committee reserves the right to refuse and/or limit entries that are deemed inappropriate, unable to be properly displayed or adequately secured.

Entry Information

- Entries will be accepted at Montpelier Mansion (Rte 197 & Muirkirk Rd, Laurel, Md.) on Sunday July 12th from 4-6 pm & Monday July 13th from 10 am - 2 pm.
- 2) Junior Amateur entry fees are \$4; all other entry fees are \$5.
- 3) Each entry must have a separate completed entry form (see below) photocopied forms are acceptable.
- 4) Insurance coverage is the responsibility of the entrant.

Judging

Entries will be judged by a panel of regionally known needleart professionals. A list or ribbon recipients will be available on show days at Montpelier Mansion.

Classifications for Competition

Divisions

Professional:

Those who receive payment for design, lecturing, teaching, publishing, or working on needlework. Entries in this division will not be eligible for the Best in Show or Judges' Award.

Original:

Those works that are truly unique and have been designed by the needleworker.

Adult Amateur:

Those over 14 years of age who do not receive payment for their needlework.

Junior Amateur:

Those between the ages of 6 and 14 who do not receive payment for their needlework.

Techniques

Beading (More than 75% of work is beaded) Needlepoint (continental or tent stitch only) Counted Canvas (2 or more types of stitch) Counted Cross Stitch - Aida Counted Cross Stitch - Linen/Evenweave Samplers (six or more different stitches on Linen or Evenweave) Cutwork (Hardanger/Drawn thread) Embroidery (includes floss, silk, wool, metallic) Other (tatting, smocking, crochet, knitting, etc.) Petit-point

Special Features in 2009

In Celebration of Family, we will have a special ribbon category for heirloom samplers. Any pieces that represent family events, occasions, celebrations. In addition we would like to display any family heirloom treasures you may like to share in a non juried group. Do you have a special piece from generations passed down? We would love to show it off during the show. (Small pieces are able to be secured)

Pieces for Sale

There will be a section of finished pieces donated for sale, framed or finished as wall hangings or pillows. The proceeds from this sale will benefit the Laurel Volunteer Rescue Squad.

We will also have a few vendors in the mansion this year, featuring needlework, jewelry, glass and soaps for sale.

Demonstrations

On going throughout the show will be volunteers stitching in the hallways. We invite you to ask questions.
